TO VERIFY CONTACTS IN THE PARENT PORTAL

Every contact has to be in numerical order. Starting with the parents, then emergency contacts and then ending with the physician (if listed).

This can be done by simply scrolling down and changing the number next to the contact using the up or down arrow next to it. Then, scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the "Verify" button. If you were successful, a box will appear saying verification was successful, click OK. You will then be able to access your student's academics.
