C) Approval to Seek Waiver and Appoint Culinary Arts Teacher

WHEREAS, in 2014, the District created an in-house Career and Technical Education program for the training and preparation of students heading into the culinary field;

WHEREAS, to allow the school district to continue its pursuit of the District Mission, where all students graduate with a strong academic foundation, a solid character, a commitment to lifelong learning, and a respect for community, a diverse set of educational and technical offerings for students must be in place;

WHEREAS, the District made the decision to not contract with BOCES for this program, as the cost-benefit analysis of the two programs revealed that the in-house culinary program could service twice the number of students at a slightly less cost;

WHEREAS, the program's staffing requirements only created a need for the District to hire a candidate for two class periods (.40 FTE), and the pool of qualified candidates who could teach the course and offer our students post-secondary credit at Suffolk County Community College yielded no non-retirees;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, appoints Lawrence Weiss to the position of Culinary Arts Teacher for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, as per the established Terms & Conditions if a qualified, non-retiree candidate is not found.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Superintendent of Schools submit any and all appropriate and necessary applications to secure a Section 211 Waiver from the New York State Education Department to authorize such appointment.

D) Annual Professional Performance Review – Certification of Lead Evaluators

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education pursuant to the provisions of Education Law Section 3012-d and Part 30-3.10 of the Regents Rules hereby certifies that the following individuals have completed all of the necessary training to be certified as lead evaluators of classroom teachers: Denise Sullivan, Mark Pagano, Drew Walker, Diane Fox, Marc Meyer, Richard Triandafils, Dennis Schug, Anthony DeBlasio, Christopher Richardt, and Eric Ferraro; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education pursuant to the provisions of Education Law Section 3012-d and Part 30-3.10 of the Regents Rules, hereby certifies that Lars Clemensen has completed all of the necessary training to be certified as lead evaluators of building principals.

E) <u>Annual Professional Performance Review – Authorization to Pursue Waiver</u>

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education President is hereby authorized to sign the Signature Page for the submission of the Independent Evaluator Hardship Waiver Application for the District's Education Law Section 3012-d APPR Plan to the State Education Department for the 2017-18 school year. A copy of said application shall be incorporated by reference within the minutes of this meeting.
